Conditions

Open to players aged over 18 from:

- any CIU Club (allows entry from anywhere in Britain)
- any EASB individual member (restricted to England)
- any EASB affiliated club or league (restricted to England)

Entry fees

- CIU Club player £15
- EASB player member £20
- EASB affiliate club/league ... £25

EASB Clubs/Leagues have a standard 10% discount applicable to their fees and any entry must be made on the special form issued to them.

Format

For the early rounds, players will be drawn either home or away at club nominated on entry form by player. Matches will be drawn geographically. Early rounds will be 500 up, with semi-finals 3 hrs, and final 4 hours. There will be a neutral venue for semi-finals and final.

Administration

On receiving the draw, players will be responsible for arranging matches with the onus on the home player to make contact. The home player will also be responsible for notifying EASB of match results.

Prizes

Subject to sponsorship negotiations currently taking place the competition will provide:

- Prize money will be related to entry fees collected
- At least one nomination for the IBSF World Billiards Championship(s), which is either fully or partially funded, will be awarded to the highest placed English player(s).
- The CIU will continue to present the existing permanent trophy for this event.
