

INTERNATIONAL SELECTION CRITERIA

The EASB will nominate representatives for the following events (from 1st September, 2011) using the criteria given:

IBSF World Snooker Championship

The current champion of the EASB English Amateur Championship followed by highest ranked eligible players on the EASB Pro Ticket Tour

IBSF Ladies World Championship and EBSA European Ladies Team

The current champion of the EASB English Ladies Championship, followed by highest ranked eligible players on the EASB Ladies Tour

IBSF World Mens Team Championship

The highest ranked eligible players from the EASB Pro Ticket Tour

IBSF World Under 21 Championship

The current champion of the EASB Under 21 Championship, followed by highest ranked eligible players from the EASB Under 21 Tour

IBSF World Masters Championship

The current champion of the EASB English Masters Championship, followed by highest ranked eligible players on the EASB Masters Tour

IBSF World Billiards Championship

The highest placed English player in the EASB/CIU National Billiards Championship and the current champion of the EASB Junior Billiards Ranking Tour

IBSF/EBSA Six Reds Championship

The current champion and runner up of the EASB National 6 reds championship

EBSA Ladies Championship

The current champion of the EASB English Ladies Championship, followed by highest ranked eligible players on the EASB Ladies Tour

EBSA European Snooker Championship

The current champion and runner up of the EASB English Amateur Championship, followed by highest ranked eligible player on the EASB Pro Ticket Tour

EBSA European Team Championship

The highest ranked eligible players from the EASB Pro Ticket Tour

EBSA European Under 21 Championship

The highest ranked eligible players from the EASB Junior Premier Tour

EBSA European Masters Championship (Singles and Team)

The current champion and runner up of the EASB English Masters Championship, followed by highest ranked eligible players on the EASB Masters Tour

Home Internationals Mens Team

The current English Amateur Champion, the current English Club Players Champion, the Current Champion of the Regional Amateur Tour, and the highest eligible players from the Pro Ticket Tour.

Home Internationals Under 19 Team

The 5 highest ranked eligible players from the EASB Premier Junior Tour, and 2 highest ranked eligible players from the Under 21 Tour

Home Internationals Under 16 Team

The current EASB Under 16 Champion and the 6 highest ranked eligible players from the EASB Premier Junior Tour.

Home Internationals Masters Team

The current EASB Seniors Champion and the highest eligible players from the English Seniors ranking list.

Home Internationals Billiards Teams

Senior team: The highest placed English player in the EASB/CIU National Billiards Championship and the current champion of the National Combined Cue Sports Championship
Junior team: The winner and runner up of the National Junior Billiards Tour.

Home Internationals Ladies Team

The current EASB Ladies Champion, and the highest eligible player from the EASB Ladies Tour.

GENERAL

- 1) For the purpose of the Home Internationals, teams will be selected in the following order, irrespective of age. Mens, Masters, Under 19, Under 16, Ladies, Mens Billiards, Junior Billiards. If a player qualifies for more than one team, they will be given choice as to which team they would like to represent.
- 2) In the case of selection for events based on Ranking Lists, if players are to be nominated during a current season, then the most recent available ranking list, providing at least 50% of the season has been completed, will be used at the time nomination is required.
- 3) In the case of selection for events based on Championship competitions, if players are to be nominated before a particular event is complete, selection will be based on the previous season's results.
- 4) Selection will take account of the conditions pertaining to the relevant International tournament, which may have age or other restrictions. In all cases, the highest ranked player who both meets these criteria and is available for selection, will be nominated.
- 5) Players refusing nomination are expected to give acceptable reasons on the grounds that they are not able to participate. Absence of such may result in the player(s) not being considered for further nomination to international events. Wildcards may be substituted at the discretion of the board should any player eligible under the above criteria decline the invitation to play.
- 6) International Selection (other than for the IBSF/EBSA Team Championships) will only be awarded to players holding Individual Membership of the Association, and not that of League or Club Membership. Members subject to disciplinary proceedings may be excluded from the selection procedure.
